Participation in Stuyvesant High School Interscholastic Athletic program is completely voluntary, however it requires a commitment on your part with respect to your academic standing, citizenship, teammates and school. Therefore, the following regulations have been established for all student-athletes:

- 1. Student-athletes must be positive role models to all other students whether in Stuyvesant High School or at visiting schools
- 2. Student-athletes must abide by all rules established by the PSAL (PSAL.org) and the department of Education Discipline Code
- 3. Student-athletes must exhibit good sportsmanship at all times
- 4. Student-athletes must be on time for all classes and can not cut classes
- 5. Student-athletes are to report to practice, games, team meetings on time
- 6. Student-athletes must be present in school and must attend all assigned classes in order to participate in any team practice, scrimmage, league or non-league game, meet, contest or try-out on that day
- 7. Student-athletes must cooperate with teammates, coaches and officials at all times
- 8. Student-athletes must maintain PSAL eligibility requirements for attendance (80% in all classes) as well as PSAL academic requirements (must pass at least four major subject as well as Physical Education, if scheduled). Copies of any medical documentation in regards to attendance must be submitted to the Athletic Director
- 9. Student-athletes are required to attend all team practices, competitions and meetings. Any excuse must be provided to your coach prior to absence. The coach has the authority not to play a student should he/she not attend practice
- 10. Student-athletes that are in possession of school property which has not been assigned to them will be immediately removed from the team
- 11. Student-athletes are to adhere to additional rules established by the coach
- 12. All equipment/uniforms on loan to student-athletes must be returned to the coach at the final team meeting held at the conclusion of the season. Any equipment that is lost must be paid for. Students that do not return school equipment will be prohibited from joining any other Stuyvesant athletic team
- 13. Hazing, playing abusive tricks on a fellow student, frightening, harassing or subjecting a fellow student/teammate to personal indignity are grounds for immediate dismissal
- 14. Student-athletes will be allowed in the locker room only when their coach is present (student-athletes must use appropriate areas such as the locker room or rest rooms to change for team practice or competition; no other areas are acceptable)
- 15. Student-athletes are to avoid taking, selling, consuming any type of alcohol or drug not prescribed by a physician including cigarettes or tobacco products.
- 16. Student-athletes are not to engage in any behavior inside or outside of school that is illegal or an embarrassment to the team/school

Failure to comply with any established rule (PSAL/DOE) or the guidelines stated above will be grounds for immediate suspension or dismissal from the team by your coach, Athletic Director or Principal
